MYTH

If you have been convicted of a felony, you can never vote again.



FACT

If you have been convicted of a felony, you cannot vote UNTIL you have gotten "Off-Paper"



WHAT IS "OFF-PAPER?"

This refers to people who have been convicted of a felony, and have:

- Finished their terms of punishment
- Completed their probation
- They are no longer under any supervision



CAUTION!

It is a felony to register to vote, if you have been convicted of a felony, and are still "On-Paper,"

So please make sure you are "Off-Paper" before registering to vote
